INDICATIVE ITINERARY

DAY - 1 WELCOME TO TBILISI- HOTEL TRANSFER

Arrive in Tbilisi. You will be met by our representative and will be transferred to Hotel in Tbilisi. Georgia's ancient and vibrant capital city spreads out on both banks of the Mtkvari River, and is surrounded on three sides by mountains. The name Tbilisi derives from the Old Georgian word "tbili", meaning warm. Archaeological studies of the region indicate human settlement in the area early as the 4th millennium BC. Check-In at your Hotel in Tbilisi & rest of day is free at leisure.

Overnight stay at your hotel in Tbilisi.

DAY-2 TBILISI CITY TOUR & MTSKHETA

Breakfast in the Hotel

10:00 Tour starts

Tbilisi is one of the oldest capital cities in eastern part of Europe. The historical part of the city merging with the modern lifestyle is perfectly represented in old part of the city. Take a walk through the coblestoned streets, **Visit Sulphur baths area**, waterfall, **bridge of the peace**, **Sharden street**. Later drive to visit **Holy trinity Cathedral**, (also known as Sameba), one of the tallest churches in the world.

Lunch can be done during city tour with amazing views of downtown.

Dinner can be arranged in one of the local restaurants decorated with traditional folk show and live performances. (upon request)

Visit Ancient city **Mtskheta**, and two great monuments: **Svetitskhoveli royal Cathedral** and **Jvari monastery** of 6th century. Both of these temples together with the whole town are listed as UNESCO's sites. Mtskheta is one of the oldest constantly inhabited places in the world.

The Historical Monuments of Mtskheta are located in the cultural landscape at the confluence of the **Aragvi and Mtkvari Rivers,** in Central-Eastern Georgia, some 20km northwest of Tbilisi in Mtskheta. Mtskheta was the ancient capital of Kartli, the East Georgian Kingdom from the 3rd century BC to the 5th century AD, and was also the location where Christianity was proclaimed as the official religion of Georgia in 337. To date, it still remains the headquarters of the Georgian Orthodox and Apostolic Church.

DAY- 3 TRANSFER TO GUDAURI, ON THE WAY ANANURI & SHINVALI

10:00 Tour starts

Discover Georgia in a snowy winter with one-day snow tour to Gudauri from Tbilisi (about 2 hr 30 min (121 kms). **Gudauri** is a ski resort located on the south-facing plateau of The Greater Caucasus Mountain Range in Georgia. Enjoy breathtaking views of the Caucasus Mountains at an altitude of 2000 m and enjoy skiing in one of the best ski mountain resorts in Georgia. This one-day snow tour to Gudauri combines the best of both, cultural and active winter tour



Drive toward Caucasus mountains along legendary Georgian military highway. En route photo-stop at Jinvali water reservoir, Ananuri Architectural complex and Pasanauri Confluence of rivers black & white

Aragvi. Later arrive in Gudauri Georgia-Russian friendship Monument with panoramic view, New

Gudauri Ski sport (various kinds of snow activities will be available at this site).

DAY- 4 KAZBEGI TOUR WITH JEEP

Breakfast at the hotel. today, have the tour in one of the most popular touristic destination in Georgia – Kazbegi. First, drive to Kazbegi and change the transport to 4x4 vehicle to ride up on the top of mountain and visit the Gergeti Monastery, which is surrounded by huge mountains of mysterious Caucasus. Later, drive to Dariali Gorge, which is most important historical center of country – main border of Georgia and Russia. On the way back to Gudauri, later drive to Sno Village and survey the surrounding. Returning to the hotel in Gudauri and rest.

DAY - 5 TRANSFER TO TBILISI ON THE WAY TO MTSKHETA

Breakfast at the hotel. At about 10:00 am, Check out from the hotel in Gudauri and drive to the hometown of world known historical person – **Joseph Stalin**. Visit the **museum of Stalin** there. The Joseph Stalin Museum is a museum in Gori, Georgia dedicated to the life of Joseph Stalin, the leader of the Soviet Union, who was born in Gori. The museum retains its Soviet-era characteristics. Then, drive to **Uplistilhe Caved Town**. Upon returning to Tbilisi, we will stop at Tbilisi Mall for shopping. Later, visit the Orbeliani Bazaar, where guests can buy the bio fruits and vegetables. There you can degustate the delicious tastes of local street food. Free evening for your own in this beautiful capital city.
