Overview

You'll travel past New Zealand's largest lake, Lake Taupo, and enjoy lunch at a local farm in Marton. Go sightseeing in the New Zealand capital of Wellington and take in its vibrant art and dining scene. See the Beehive and Parliament buildings, then take in the sweeping views of the harbor from Mount Victoria.

Embark on one of the world's most scenic ferry rides across the Marlborough Sound keeping an eye out for dolphins, penguins, or whales on your way to Christchurch. Explore the land of towering mountains, rugged coastlines, and vast plains of New Zealand's south island as you venture on to Queenstown. Enjoy free time to explore this "adventure capital" before your breathtaking cruise on Milford Sound. Here, be awed by waterfalls, sheer cliff walls, and tropical





rainforests surrounding the marine home of seals, penguins, and dolphins. This budget-minded tour of New Zealand is nothing short of spectacular. Enjoy the idyllic and fantastic scenes around each turn in your escorted vacation from Auckland to Queenstown.

Itinerary

Day 1

ARRIVE AUCKLAND, NEW ZEALANDKia ora and welcome to New Zealand! Hotel rooms are available for immediate check-in. A pre-night is not required for early check-in.

Day 2

AUCKLANDThis morning begins with a welcome briefing to meet fellow passengers and your Tour Director. Day 3

AUCKLAND-ROTORUALeave Auckland this morning and journey through lush farmland to Rotorua, home to New Zealand's Máori culture and geothermal wonders. Our first stop is Te Puia where a guided tour allows you to see bubbling mud, pools of boiling water, and the famous Pohutu Geyser, the largest active geyser in the southern hemisphere. You'll also have a chance to witness traditional Máori carving and weaving along with a Máori cultural performance. Then, visit Agrodome to learn more about one of the country's major industriessheep! This evening is at leisure.

Day 4

ROTORUAToday is free to explore more of Rotorua. You may wish to take an optional excursion to visit magical Hobbiton, the set used as the Shire in the movie trilogies, The Lord of the Rings and The Hobbit. Other options include a zipline and canopy tour, helicopter and floatplane flights over the volcanic valley, or a relaxing soak in a natural hot spring at the Polynesian Spa. Indulge in an evening of singing, storytelling, and sizzling meats and veggies prepared on underground hot stones in true Máori fashion. Hang out with an optional Hangi dinner with a side of authentic cultural performances in the indigenous Polynesian tradition.

ROTORUA-LAKE TAUPO-MARTON-WELLINGTONToday, continue your journey on the North Island traveling past Lake Taupo, New Zealand's largest lake. Stop in the historic town of Marton to visit a local farm for lunch. During your time here, tour a tour of the farm and learn about the importance of the sheep industry to the local economy. Continue to Wellington, New Zealand's capital city known for its vibrant art scene, world-class restaurant culture, and active outdoor lifestyle.

Continue to Christchurch, the largest city on the South Island for an overnight stay.

Stop at beautiful Lake Tekapo for a visit to the picturesque Church of the Good Shepherd. Later, arrive in Queenstown, the "Adventure Capital," for a 3-night stay. This evening you may want to take the Skyline Gondola to the top of Bob's Peak, where you'll enjoy breathtaking views of Queenstown and Lake Wakatipu below.
