#### **Personal Documents**



## Valid Passport

- Must be less than 10 years old and valid for at least 6 months beyond the intended stay.
- Should contain at least 2 blank pages and be submitted with all previous passports.
- **Not accepted**: Handwritten passports, passports with observations, and 20-year validity passports.



## Signed Visa Form

- Must be electronically generated with a barcode receipt after completing the application on <u>VIDEX</u>. <a href="https://videx.diplo.de/videx/visum-erfassung/videx-kurzfristiger-aufenthalt">https://videx.diplo.de/videx/visum-erfassung/videx-kurzfristiger-aufenthalt</a>
- Visa applications are accepted strictly by appointment only.



### **Passport Copies**

• Photocopies of the **front and last pages** of the passport.



## Passport-Sized Photos

- 2 recent color photographs (not used previously for any visa).
- Specifications:

Size: 35mm x 45mmFinish: Matte paperBackground: White

o **Face coverage:** 80%, non-smiling

 No glasses, hats, or head coverings, unless for religious or ethnic reasons.



## **Signed Cover Letter**

- Addressed to **The Visa Officer**, **Embassy of Germany**, stating:
  - Duration & purpose of the visit
  - o Expense responsibility
  - o Applicant details (name, passport number, etc.)



**Declaration Form (Annexure C)** – Signed by the applicant.



## Proof of Civil Status (if applicable)

- Marriage certificate (not required if the spouse's name is on the passport).
- Divorce decree (if applicable).
- Birth certificate of children (if applicable).
- Spouse's death certificate (if applicable).
- Ration card (if applicable).

## **Confirmed Hotel Bookings**

• Must match the **travel itinerary**, including the **hotel name**, **address**, **phone number**, **and email**.



## **Confirmed Air Tickets**

• Round-trip tickets covering all travel sectors.



## Day-to-Day Itinerary

• Detailed travel schedule.



#### Travel Insurance

- Must meet Schengen specifications with coverage of €30,000.
- Should be valid for the **entire trip** and state that coverage applies **worldwide**.
- List of approved insurance companies is available on the visa forms section of the website.



## If Visiting a Relative in Germany

• Original sponsorship letter (Déclaration d'Accueil) obtained from the local town hall in Germany.

#### **Proof of Financial Means**



#### Rank Statement

• Original personal bank statement for the last 6 months, stamped and signed by the bank.



## **Income Tax Returns (ITR)**

• Personal ITR for the last 3 years.

## **Occupation-Specific Documents**



## If Employed

- Last 3 months' salary slips.
- NOC from employer confirming leave approval and job status.



## If a Business Owner/Proprietor

- Company bank statement for the last 6 months, stamped by the bank.
- Company's ITR for the last 3 years.
- Company registration proof (GST, Incorporation Certificate, Partnership Deed, etc.).
- Cover letter on company letterhead confirming business details and travel purpose.



### If a Student

- Leave letter from school.
- School ID copy.



#### If Retired

- Retirement proof.
- Pension statements for the last 3 months.
- Proof of additional income (e.g., rental properties, business earnings).



#### If Sponsored

• **Proof of sponsorship/private accommodation** by submitting the **official sponsorship form** of the Schengen State concerned.
