

The park takes its name from a Maasai word meaning "salty dust". Wildlife abounds with elephants being the dominant species. The park also offers the best views for photography and also gives an opportunity to focus on

extra activities like tree planting and Maasai Village visits.

This day will be spent in the park with a full day game drive and any other optional activity as suggested by your tour guide.

Amboseli -Lake Naivasha

Day 4 - Wednesday

Lake Naivasha National park is part of Kenya's Rift Valley, a region known for picturesque lakes and landscape, Primarily known for its many species of birds, including vast numbers of pink flamingos, Lake Naivasha also has waterbucks, impalas, and hippopotamuses

Spend the day in Maasai Mara with morning and afternoon game drives. The Mara is home to the big five and a host of other game.

Masai Mara is one of Kenya's most visited and richest game reserve with a huge density of wildlife including the big five. It is also famous for the great wildebeest migration that occurs annually. The great migration involves the wildebeest, zebra and gazelle instinct led movement from the Serengeti in Tanzania around July to the Masai Mara in Kenya and then departing around October. This journey is coupled by numerous obstacles which makes it even more magnificent.
