Who uses this form

You should use this form if you are applying for a visitor visa as:

- A tourist or visiting family or friends
- A business visitor
- The dependent child of a New Zealand citizen or resident
- The dependent child of a work or student visa holder
- The parent or grandparent of a New Zealand citizen or resident

You can use this form to apply for a visa for a single person or a family. Family may include a principal applicant, partner and dependent children under 20.

You can also use this form if you are under 25 and are applying as the dependent child of a work visa holder or a New Zealand citizen or resident. You must also be included in, or have made, a residence application as a dependent child under one of the following categories:

- Dependent Child Resident Visa
- Partnership Category
- Skilled Migrant Category
- Green List: Straight to Residence
- Green List: Work to Residence
- Care Workforce: Work to Residence
- Transport Sector: Work to Residence
